Local Law No 2 of the year 2021

A local law adopted pursuant to the Marihuana Regulation and Taxation Act and specifically Cannabis Law § 131 opting out of licensing and establishing on-site cannabis consumption establishments within the Village of Stillwater.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Village of Stillwater as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law is to opt the Village of Stillwater out of hosting on-site cannabis consumption establishments within its boundaries.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to the terms of the Marihuana Regulation and Taxation Act and specifically Cannabis Law § 131, which expressly authorizes cities, towns and villages to opt-out of allowing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments to locate and operate within their boundaries.

Section 3. Local Cannabis On-Site Consumption Opt-Out

The Village Board of the Village of Stillwater, County of Saratoga, hereby opts-out of licensing and establishing cannabis on-site consumption establishments within its boundaries.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to

the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State. Pursuant to the Marihuana Regulation and Taxation Act and Cannabis Law § 131, this local law is subject to a permissive referendum and/or referendum by motion of the Village Board pursuant to Village Law § 9-908 and thus may not be filed with the Secretary of State until the applicable time period has elapsed to file a petition or a referendum has been conducted approving this local law.
